**Ley Creek Transfer Station Now
Serves Residential Customers Only
Thursday through Saturday**
*Commercial customers use the Rock Cut Road
Transfer Station Monday through Friday*



SYRACUSE, N.Y. (August 19, 2020) — The Ley Creek Transfer Station in Liverpool offers trash and recycling drop off to residential customers Thursday through Saturday.

Previously, the site served both residential and commercial customers Monday through Friday. With commercial customers moved to the Rock Cut Road Transfer Station this summer, a new Thursday through Saturday operating schedule at Ley Creek was developed to better accommodate residents' needs.

“OCRRA is pleased to serve commercial customers Monday through Friday at the newly renovated Rock Cut Road Transfer Station and provide residential trash and recycling services at the Ley Creek Transfer Station Thursday through Saturday,” said Dereth Glance, OCRRA Executive Director.

Closed Sunday.

Ley Creek Transfer Station fee details are below.

LEY CREEK RESIDENTIAL FEES

Cash or check only, no credit cards
(Commercial customers will be directed to OCRRA's Rock Cut Road Transfer Station)

- Cars and minivans: \$15
- Pickup trucks, SUVs, vans, single-axle trailers: \$30

Additional Disposal Fees

Fees charged in addition to regular disposal fees

- Appliances with refrigerants (CFCs): \$15 each
- Mattresses: \$15 each
- Microwaves: \$5 each
- Passenger tires up to 20” in diameter (Rims must be removed. Limit 10 tires.): \$7 each

Other Fees and Services:

- Residential recyclable drop-off: FREE
- Residential trash bag stickers: \$3/sticker
- Untarped vehicle fee: \$25
